Minden-Tahoe asks for your cooperation in reducing the noise impact of aircraft on our neighboring communities.

**CAUTION**

Migratory birds in the vicinity of the airport. Use caution for gliders and skydiving activity on and nearby the airport. Men and equipment occasionally on runways and taxiways.

**Preferred Departure Routes**

**Runway 34**

Northbound – Turn left heading 320 before crossing Johnson Lane  
Southbound – Avoid residential areas

**Runway 16**

Northbound – Avoid residential areas  
Southbound – Straight out climb to reduce noise over residential areas

**Runway 30**

Northbound – Avoid residential areas  
Southbound – Avoid residential areas

**Runway 12**

Northbound – Avoid residential areas  
Southbound – Avoid residential areas

**Noise Abatement Procedures**

Please be cognizant of the surrounding communities. There are noise sensitive areas to the North and south of the Airport. Aircraft are asked to climb and maintain at least 1500 feet AGL before crossing any populated areas.

**Runway 34 is the preferred Calm Wind Runway**

**Noise Reduction Tips**

Reduce propeller RPM as soon as safe and practical. Even a reduction of 200 RPM can significantly reduce noise.

Climb out at Vx (may not be practical in all aircraft, refer to the POH)

Avoid abrupt power changes

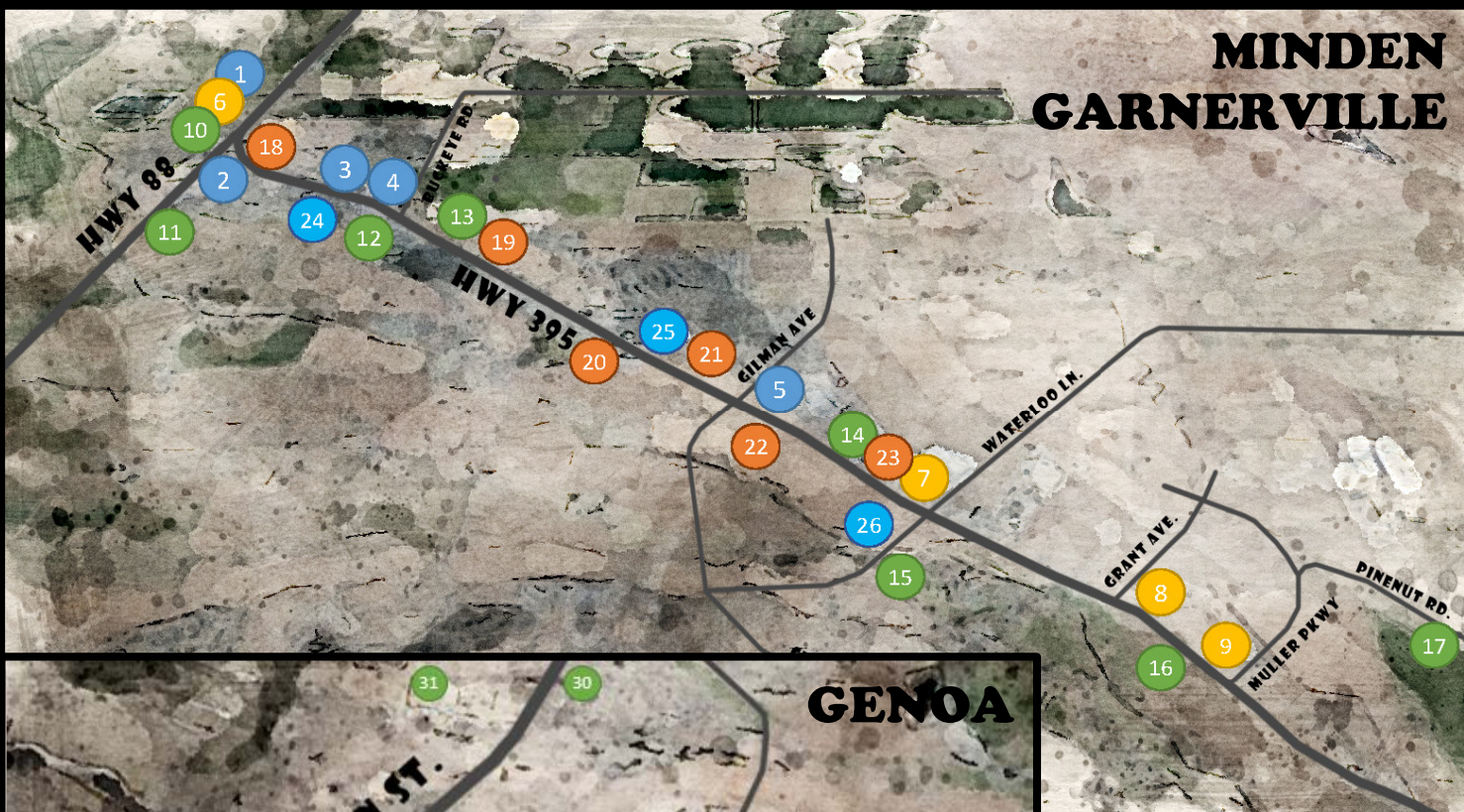

## MINDEN



The Town of Minden was named after Minden, Germany, near the birthplace of H.F. Dangberg. There is no question that the Dangbergs created our town. The Minden Inn was a getaway destination for some of the biggest names in Hollywood, including Clark Gable and Jean Harlow.

## GARDNERVILLE



Gardnerville got its start in 1879, when Lawrence Gilman purchased the Kent House and had it moved from its location south of Genoa to a seven-acre parcel of land on the east fork of the Carson River. There, near the site of what is today the J.T. Basque Bar and Dining Room, the building was converted to a hotel.

## GENOA



John Reese settled Genoa, the oldest town in Nevada, in 1851. Within the main town square, you will find Mormon Station State Historic Park, the Courthouse Museum of Genoa, and the Oldest Bar in Nevada.
